RESHARPEN SMART KNIVES



We have changed the way that we deal with the exchange of Smart Knives, most of you know as 'Resharpening'. It's a bit more flexible, fair and puts the onus on you managing the returns.

If we receive a smart knife for resharpen before, or at the point of sale, you will receive the new unit for £9.99.

If we receive the smart knife/knives retrospectively, we will issue a credit of £5 on to your account. This will add value to those of you who have collected a hoard of smart knives over a period of time.

You should only ever really require two or three units max to facilitate a productive rotation, keeping a 'new' unit on the shelf at any one time, whilst one is being returned for exchange.

'SPRING' WASHERS Vs NYLOCK NUTS

As you all should know, in order to meet the fixing criteria of BS8415, we are required to use some form of locking nuts.

We have been using NYLOC style Hexagonal Locking Nuts for a while now and feedback from Mason's is that they are a bit like Marmite; you either love them, or hate them.

We have offered an alternative for some time, but in case you weren't aware you can also use an aptly named 'Spring' washer in conjunction with your standard washer and still meet the fixing regulations. A 'Spring' blessing for some of you...

We've recently added a video that showcases our own gilding technique from start to finish, which has become quite popular.


MEMORIAL DESIGNER
